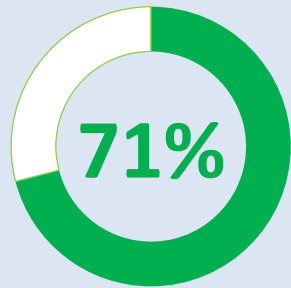
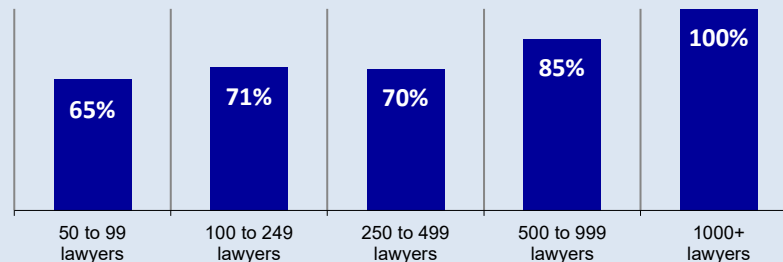

Law firms have gotten much more serious in recent years ...

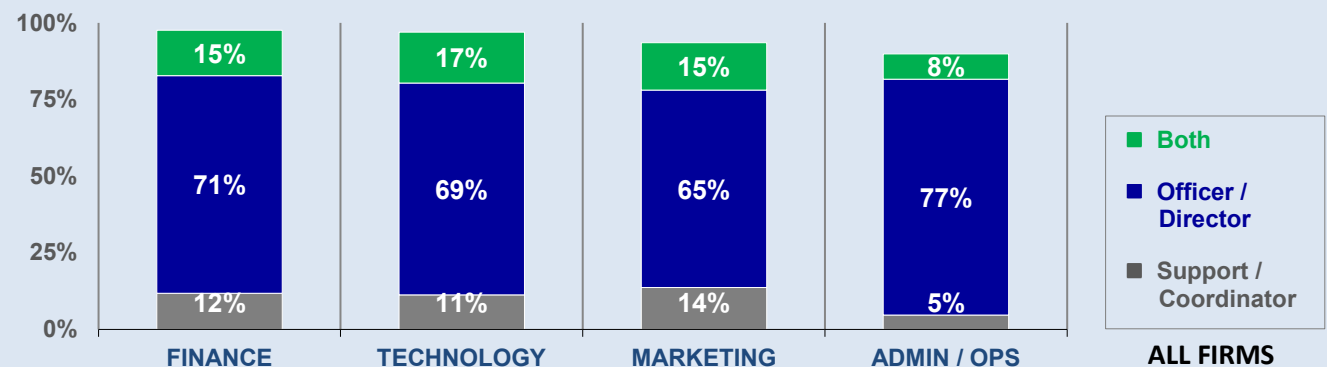

The vast majority of firms...

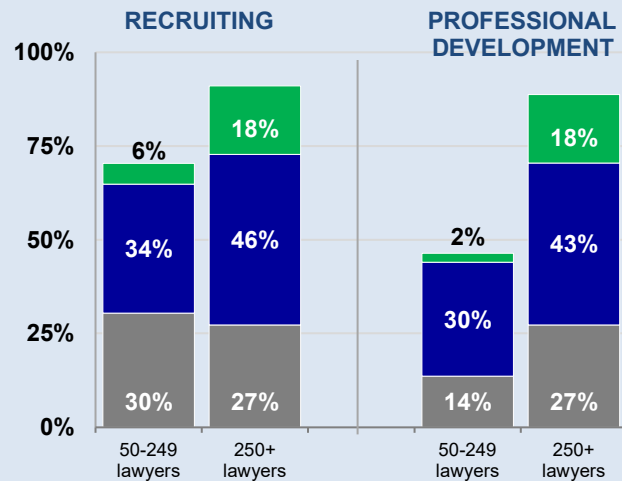

Some smaller firms have full-time coordinators covering one or more of these roles instead. As firm size increases, the size and depth of law firms' core administrative teams grow.

The Core Team: Finance, Technology, Marketing and Operations

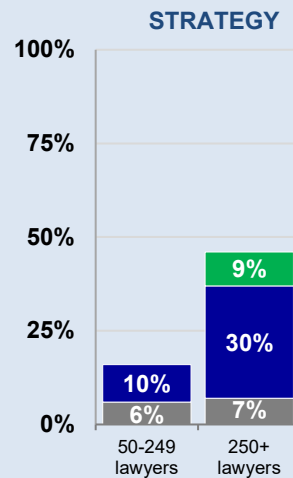


The Law Firm C-Suite 2020 – Specialists by Firm Size

More specialized C-Suite roles...

are more prevalent in larger law firms with greater resources. Recruiting and Professional Development are well-established roles as indicated by the significant number of officer-level positions across firm sizes. Data Analytics, Pricing, Process Improvement, Value and Innovation are all newer functions. These are more likely to be staffed at the coordinator level in smaller firms, while most officer-level jobs are found in firms with over 500 lawyers.
